SUBJECT: FLAG POLICY

School Board Policy 8810, *The American Flag and Official Motto of the State of Florida*, states that the flag of the United States “shall be raised above each school and/or at other appropriate places during all school sessions, weather permitting. The flag shall be raised before the opening of school and taken down at its close every day. The flag is to be flown at half-staff in mourning for designated principal government leaders and upon presidential or gubernatorial order.” This policy also provides that “Each classroom shall display a flag of the United States that is at least two (2) feet by three (3) feet, and that “The official motto of the State of Florida, "In God We Trust," shall be displayed in a conspicuous place in all schools in the District and in each building used by the School Board.”

Florida Statute section 1000.06, *Display of Flags*, outlines that each public K-20 educational institution that is provided or authorized by the Constitution and laws of Florida shall display daily in each classroom the flag of the United States. It is important that the District adhere to section 1000.06 and Board Policy 8810, to allow the District to remain neutral with regard to the display of flags at schools and restrict the display of flags that promote a political issue, political party, and political candidates.

This agenda item seeks the Board’s approval to direct the Superintendent to review existing relevant School Board Policies, State Statutes, Federal Guidelines, and if necessary, amend School Board Policy 8810, *The American Flag and Official Motto of the State of Florida*, to ensure that the American flag and the official motto of the State of Florida is displayed as described in School Board Policy 8810 and Florida Statute 1000.06. The only other flags that may be displayed are those used as part of a temporary unit of study within the approved curriculum.

This item has been reviewed and approved by the School Board Attorney’s office as to form and legal sufficiency.

**ACTION PROPOSED BY

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, direct the Superintendent to:

1. review existing relevant School Board Policies, State Statutes, Federal Guidelines, and if necessary, amend School Board Policy 8810, *The American Flag and Official Motto of the State of Florida*, to ensure that the American flag and the official motto of the State of Florida is displayed as described in School Board Policy 8810;
2. if deemed necessary, initiate rulemaking to amend relevant School Board Policies; and
3. Provide an update at the Academics, Innovation, Evaluation, and Technology Committee meeting on Wednesday, December 7, 2022.
