Human trafficking is another American horror story, its simply modern-day slavery. It involves exploiting a person through force, fraud, or coercion for the purpose of forced labor, commercial sex, or both. This \$150 billion business does not seem to discriminate; victims of human trafficking include men, women, boys, girls, and transgender individuals. Some victims were lured by the promise of a better life while others were stripped away from loved ones without any consent.

Florida is ranked third nationwide in human trafficking cases, and Miami-Dade County is basically the epicenter of Florida. Schools can play a huge role in keeping our kids safe and out of trafficker's way. Our schoolhouses should serve as a safe place for all our children, especially our students whose homes already lack safety or security. It takes a village to ensure the safety of our students. Everyone within our schools play a role starting with our bus drivers, food service staff, instructors, office employees, and ending with our administrators. We must understand the warning signs, learn the indicators of this crime and how to assist a student that is an apparent victim.

This item seeks to further commend local, state, and national efforts to increase awareness of human trafficking by recognizing January as Human Trafficking Awareness Month throughout Miami-Dade County Public Schools.
