**SUBJECT: COMPREHENSIVE REVIEW OF TRANSPORTATION GUIDELINES, INCLUDING STUDENT DISCIPLINE ACTIONS, WHILE STUDENTS ARE RIDING A MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS BUS**

Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) is aware of several video clips circulating on social media platforms involving students engaged in prohibited and unsafe behavior while riding an M-DCPS school bus. The school district has taken immediate and appropriate disciplinary action has been initiated for those students involved, pursuant to the Code of Student Conduct. The Miami-Dade Schools Police has taken swift action and is continuously assisting in the investigation to ensure that the unfortunate events are accurate, securing any additional information available as to what led to these unruly actions, and determining what future recommendations for consideration by the School Board may be taken. It is important to ascertain that these unacceptable events are deterred while students ride M-DCPS buses. The safety and security of all students is of utmost importance to the School Board, the Superintendent of Schools, the administration, school site administrators, the transportation department, and all bus drivers and bus aides.

Therefore, this agenda item proposes to direct the Superintendent of Schools to conduct a comprehensive review of transportation guidelines, including student discipline actions, while students are riding a Miami-Dade County Public Schools bus. This comprehensive review should include, but is not limited to:

- Evaluation of current procedures, protocols, policies, professional development offerings for bus drivers, bus aides, and school site administrators, governing the safe transportation of students while they ride M-DCPS buses.

  - d.
