SUBJECT: REQUEST SCHOOL BOARD APPROVAL OF TWO NEW CHARTER SCHOOL APPLICATIONS AND THIRTEEN CHARTER SCHOOL CONTRACT RENEWALS

COMMITTEE: PERSONNEL, STUDENT, SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY SUPPORT

CHARTER SCHOOL APPLICATIONS

Section 1002.33, F.S. authorizes the establishment of charter schools by individuals and/or organizations. As provided in section 1002.33(6), F.S. and School Board Policy 9800, *Charter Schools* (Policy 9800), Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) (District) receives and reviews charter school applications for charter schools to be opened at a time determined by the applicant. M-DCPS then submits the applications with a recommendation for approval or denial to the School Board. Section 1002.33(6)(b)(3)(a), F.S. requires that the School Board, as the Sponsor, approve or deny an application no later than 90 calendar days after receipt, unless the Sponsor and the applicant mutually agree in writing to temporarily postpone the vote to a specific date.

CHARTER SCHOOL APPLICATION EVALUATION

Pursuant to Policy 9800, the District reviews all applications using an evaluation instrument developed by the Florida Department of Education (FDOE) and may request additional information. The FDOE Standard Model Application includes standards of evaluation, certification and assurance declarations, and an Applicant History Addendum.

Policy 9800 requires the Superintendent to convene the charter school Application Review Committee (ARC) to meet publicly and conduct final reviews of charter school applications and to provide the Superintendent with a recommendation for presentation to the School Board. The ARC met and identified strengths and/or deficiencies in the written applications, as well as areas that required clarification, to fully evaluate the quality of the applications and the capacity of the applicants to properly implement the proposed plan. Pursuant to Policy 9800, two (2) charter school applications and associated evaluations are being presented for final approval or denial by the School Board as set forth herein.

Two (2) new charter school applications are being presented for consideration in this item. One of the charter school applications, if approved, has proposed to open for the 2023-2024 school year and the other is projected to open for the 2024-2025 school year. It is important to note that, pursuant to section 1002.33(6)(b)(5), F.S., upon written notice at least thirty (30) calendar days before the first day of school, approved applicants may defer the opening of the school's operation for up to three years to provide time for adequate facility planning. An overview of the charter school applications is contained in Table 1. The applications and evaluation instruments can be accessed through the link provided on page 4. CHARTER SCHOOL CONTRACT RENEWALS

Section 1002.33(7), F.S. outlines the issues involved in the operation of charter schools to be considered in advance and written into a charter school contract between the charter school and the School Board following a public meeting, and also establishes the guidelines for renewal of existing charter contracts. Pursuant to Policy 9800, thirteen (13) charter school contract renewals are being presented for consideration in this item.

Policy 9800 requires that the Superintendent convene the Contract Review Committee (CRC) to meet publicly and negotiate charter school renewal contracts for presentation to the School Board for their final decision. Additionally, each school presented for renewal has undergone a performance review prior to being considered for a renewal contract. An overview of the contracts being presented in this item can be found in Table 2. Additional details for each of these contracts may be found in Attachment A. The actual contracts can be accessed through the links provided on page 4. The attachments and links are included and incorporated by reference in this Board item.

* A 15-year charter renewal must be granted to a charter school that has demonstrated the successful accomplishment of criteria pursuant to s.1002.33(7)(a),(c), F.S., has received a school grade of "A" or "B" pursuant to s. 1008.34 F.S. in the most recently graded school year, and that is not in a state of financial emergency or deficit position as defined by statute.

** Pursuant to s.1002.331(2), F.S., "high-performing" is a designation, made by the Commission of Education for certain charter schools, which provides certain authority for the school to increase enrollment, expand grade levels, submit quarterly rather than monthly financial reports, consolidate charters, and/or modify the charter term for up to 15 years. Recent changes in legislation also allow a high-performing charter school to increase enrollment beyond the contract capacity, but not to exceed the capacity of the facility at the time enrollment will take effect.

DISTRICT IMPACT

Any significant increase in charter school student enrollment (Charter FTE) directly impacts the District's operating budget as well as instructional and non-instructional staffing levels. One of the renewal charter school contracts is included in the analysis of Total Loss as they present a potential increase in overall charter school enrollment or an anticipated loss to the District.

Initial Year Loss (2023-2024 SY): The revenue and positions indicated as "District Impact" provide an estimate of the potential impact on the District's General Fund (\$454,875) instructional staffing (5 positions), and non-instructional staffing (3 positions). The loss of revenue is based on 95% of FEFP funds per student and 75% of the enrollment projection that the District will not realize.

** Pursuant to s.1002.331(2), F.S., "high-performing" is a designation, made by the Commission of Education for certain charter schools, which provides certain authority for the school to increase enrollment, expand grade levels, submit quarterly rather than monthly financial reports, consolidate charters, and/or modify the charter term for up to 15 years. Recent changes in legislation also allow a high-performing charter school to increase enrollment beyond the contract capacity, but not to exceed the capacity of the facility at the time enrollment will take effect.
