The employees listed herein were provided written notice of the recommended disciplinary action in their respective cases.

- **RECOMMENDED**: 1) That the School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, approve the Superintendent's recommendation for disciplinary action, which has been agreed to by the employees.

Campbell: suspension without pay from his position as Grounds Leadperson at Maintenance Service Center 1, for five (5) calendar days, effective March 16, 2023, for just cause, including, but not limited to: gross insubordination; and violation of School Board Policies 4210, Standards of Ethical Conduct; 4210.01, Code of Ethics; and 4380, Threatening Behavior Toward Staff Members.
