A request has been received for the Miami Norland Senior High School Students to travel out-of-country. All arrangements are in accordance with School Board Policy 2340 – Field and other District-Sponsored Trips and with School Board Policy 8640-Transportation for field and other District- Sponsored Trips.

The State Department alerts U.S. citizens to possible risks of travel due to increased threats. There is always the possibility that a change in the travel alert may occur prior to a trip. When there is a travel warning the affected trips will not be allowed to take place.
