Procurement Management Services, at the request of the Department of Food and Nutrition, released the above-referenced solicitation. The purpose of this Invitation to Bid (ITB) is to establish a contract, at firm unit prices, to provide pest inspection, evaluation and treatment components of an Integrated Pest Management (IPM) program for specified areas for Miami-Dade County Public Schools. This is a term bid which states that the Board may purchase services as needed but is not obligated to purchase any guaranteed amount. This ITB was advertised on the Procurement Management Services website and DemandStar. This contract impacts 465 culinary and home economic labs across the District, which breaks down to an annual amount of \$430.11 per location. The solicitation was shared with the District's Office of Economic Opportunity (OEO) for additional community outreach.

The initial term of the bid shall be for a period of three (3) years, commencing April 17, 2024 through April 16, 2027, and may, by mutual agreement between The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, and the successful bidders, be extended for two (2) additional one (1) year periods.

Pursuant to School Board Policy 6320.02, the Goal Setting Committee recommended that this solicitation be open with a 5% price preference for SBE/MBE certified firms.

Five (5) vendors responded to this advertised bid. M-DCPS OEO staff verified the Small, Micro, Veteran and/or M/WBE certification status of the firm(s). Based on the criteria listed in the solicitation, the contract shall be awarded to two (2) vendors meeting the minimum requirements, both of which are certified.

In Fiscal Year 2022-2023, the District spent \$144,645 on food service and food laboratories pest control services.
