Section 1006.07(6)(a)4, Florida Statutes, requires school districts to conduct a school security risk assessment at each public school using the Florida Safe Schools Assessment Tool developed by the Office of Safe Schools.

In addition, the district's school safety specialist shall provide recommendations to the district school superintendent and the district school board which identify strategies and activities that the district school board should implement in order to address the findings and improve school safety and security.

Reports and all associated school safety information derived from the FSSAT are classified as For Official Use Only and are protected from public disclosure under s. 281.301 F.S., s. 286.0113 F.S. and s. 1006.1493(5) F.S., and exempt from public records requests under s. 119.071 (2) (d) and 119.071(3)(a) F.S.

The completed report will be forwarded to the Board prior to the Board Meeting of October 16, 2024.
