SUBJECT: REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT GRANT AWARDS/DONATIONS FROM MULTIPLE FUNDING SOURCES AND ENTER INTO CONTRACTUAL SERVICE AGREEMENTS WITH THE AGENCIES PRESCRIBED IN THE GRANT

Authorization is requested to accept three grant awards and two donations in accordance with Budget Summary Forms, Attachments 1.a. through 1.c., for the approximate total of \$11,618,578, as follows:

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept three grant awards and two donations from:
 - a. Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services for funding under Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program, in the approximate amount of \$1,601,700, for the grant period of July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025;
 - b. Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for funding under the Miami-Dade County Public Schools for Miami Arts Studio 6-12 @ Zelda Glazer program, in the approximate amount of \$300,000, for the grant period of July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025;

- c. Impact Florida, Inc. for funding under the Education Innovation and Research (EIR) Program Mid-Phase Grants program, in the approximate amount of \$100,000, and for in-kind services valued at \$1,893,750, for the grant period of January 1, 2024, through December 31, 2028;
 - d. Florida International University for in-kind support under the Florida International University After-School All-Stars Program, valued in the approximate amount of \$5,223,128, for the grant period of August 1, 2024, through July 31, 2025; and
 - e. United States Soccer Foundation, Inc. for in-kind support under the Mini-Pitch Program, valued in the approximate amount of \$2,500,000, for the grant period of October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2034.
2. enter into contractual service agreements with the agencies prescribed in the grant, with whom the School Board must contract, pursuant to Board Policy 6320 – Purchase Approval and Competitive; Bidding Process Requirements;
 3. extend these programs and contractual agreements and authorize the acceptance of additional funding as provided by official notification from the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the program;
 4. retain funds from the grant in an amount not to exceed the annually negotiated indirect cost rate, as allowed and approved by the FLDOE;
 5. direct Financial Services to establish appropriations in the amount approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board;
 6. authorize travel out-of-state as required by the grant parameters; and
 7. eliminate any grant-funded position upon cessation of the grant funds, and place the impacted employee(s) on the Personnel Action Listing of Instructional and Non-Instructional Appointments, Reassignments, Leaves and Separations for the relevant period.
