SUBJECT: REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT GRANT AWARDS/DONATIONS FROM MULTIPLE FUNDING SOURCES AND ENTER INTO CONTRACTUAL SERVICE AGREEMENTS WITH THE AGENCIES PRESCRIBED IN THE GRANT

Authorization is requested to accept one grant award and one donation in accordance with Budget Summary Form, Attachment 1.a., for the approximate total of \$4,812,468, as follows:

Safety and Security of School Buildings	Florida Department of Education (FLDOE)	\$4,687,468 This allocation is a \$186,646 or 3.83% decrease from the 2023 – 2026 allocation.	July 1, 2024 - January 31, 2027	Allocation	To improve the physical security of school buildings based upon recommendations from the state security risk assessment tool.
Modern Band Miami	Music Will, Inc.	Equipment and services valued at \$125,000	July 1, 2024 – June 30, 2025	Donation	To expand modern band music programming at school sites.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept one grant award and one donation from:

- a. Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for funding under Safety and Security of School Buildings, in the approximate amount of \$4,687,468, for the grant period of July 1, 2024, through January 31, 2027; and
 - b. Music Will, Inc. for in-kind equipment and services under Modern Band Miami, in the approximate amount of \$125,000, for the grant period of July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025.
2. enter into contractual service agreements with the agencies prescribed in the grant, with whom the School Board must contract, pursuant to Board Policy 6320 – Purchase Approval and Competitive; Bidding Process Requirements:
 3. extend these programs and contractual agreements and authorize the acceptance of additional funding as provided by official notification from the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the program;
 4. retain funds from the grant in an amount not to exceed the annually negotiated indirect cost rate, as allowed and approved by the FLDOE;
 5. direct Financial Services to establish appropriations in the amount approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board;
 6. authorize travel out-of-state as required by the grant parameters; and
 7. eliminate any grant-funded position upon cessation of the grant funds and place the impacted employee(s) on the Personnel Action Listing of Instructional and Non-Instructional Appointments, Reassignments, Leaves and Separations for the relevant period.
