**ACTION PROPOSED BY
MR. ROBERTO J. ALONSO:**

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, direct the Superintendent to:

1. Explore the feasibility of establishing a District school dedicated to serving students with autism at the County Club Middle School facility;
2. If deemed appropriate, partner with entities who already provide these services, such as SFACS, in establishing this school, and analyze the feasibility of this potential partnership with SFACS, including potential enrollment, programming needs, space utilization, and necessary facility upgrades, and leveraging the recent state funding;
3. If the new use of the facility is deemed feasible and appropriate, evaluate the financial implications for the District of establishing such a school, including potential revenue through leasing and management fees; and
4. Present findings and recommendations to the Board at the October 2025 Facilities and Construction Committee Meeting.
