The G. Holmes Braddock Senior High School boys swim team won the FHSA Class 4A State Championship in 2024, securing the school's first-ever state title in the sport, dominating the Class 4A state championship in Florida with 306 points, an impressive 79-point margin over the runner-up, Windermere High School. The team's journey included significant improvements over previous years: finishing 33rd in 2022, rising to runners-up in 2023, and culminating with the championship in 2024.

This historic win also marked the first state championship for any sport in Braddock's 35-year history.

The team is led by Coach Katia Garcia, the Miami-Dade County Public Schools Coach of the Year. Ms. Garcia is a three-time Miami Herald Coach of the Year. Reflecting on the team's breakthrough, she shared, "We came up short of the state crown on two prior occasions. We knew we had a team that could travel to Ocala and battle for the title. We won!"

The team's championship came from rigorous training schedules, dedication, and strong camaraderie among team members. The championship is seen as a monumental achievement that reflects the students' passion, commitment, and the supportive environment fostered by coaches and parents.

The school celebrated the victory and anticipated continued growth and success in the program, with returning team members aiming for another state title.
