Observing National Special Education Day commemorates the anniversary of the Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA), which was signed into law on December 2, 1975. IDEA guarantees a free and appropriate public education to students with disabilities. It emphasizes the importance of removing barriers to learning and ensuring that every child's potential is realized.

National Special Education Day encourages the integration of students with disabilities into regular classrooms, fostering a more inclusive and diverse learning environment. This day highlights the importance of Special Education Teachers and of their work to ensure the success of all students. Parents and guardians are their child's first advocates, and this day also recognizes them for their efforts in making their child's educational needs a priority.

Furthermore, National Special Education Day is an important day because it brings attention to the rights and needs of individuals with disabilities, it celebrates special education teachers, acknowledges parents' efforts and it advocates for a more inclusive and equitable education system.
