Florida Grand Opera (FGO) is the **oldest performing arts organization in Florida**: FGO traces its roots to 1941, making it the state's oldest continuous opera institution and one of the oldest in the United States. Originally founded as the *Opera Guild of Greater Miami*, it merged with the *Opera Guild, Inc.* of Fort Lauderdale in 1994 to form today's Florida Grand Opera.

Historically a cultural centerpiece of South Florida, FGO has presented countless classic and contemporary operas featuring internationally acclaimed artists. In recent years, FGO has undergone a renaissance under General Director and Chief Executive Officer Ms. Maria Todaro, who emphasizes both honoring the company's legacy and innovation for new audiences.

FGO recently launched a new in-house orchestra and features acclaimed vocalists and directors in its seasons. FGO is not just a mainstage opera, it features Studio Artist Programs: Training emerging talent, Education & Outreach: Initiatives for students, new audiences, community partners, Legacy and Innovation, and Wellness & Community Programs: through efforts like *Voices of Wellness* that connect music with veterans, first responders, and broader audiences.

FGO has premiered and produced works ranging from standard repertoire to new and regionally relevant opera, often incorporating cultural themes that reflect South Florida's diversity. The company has hosted legendary singers throughout its history and remains a vital artistic institution in the American opera landscape. but the core of FGO's advocacy is grounded in research-supported evidence that engagement with music and the arts enhances cognitive development, expands learning capacity, and helps children perform more successfully across all areas of study.
