SUBJECT: REQUEST SCHOOL BOARD APPROVAL OF ONE (1) NEW CHARTER SCHOOL APPLICATION, ONE (1) INITIAL CHARTER SCHOOL CONTRACT, FIVE (5) CHARTER SCHOOL CONTRACT AMENDMENTS, AND TWO (2) CHARTER SCHOOL CONSOLIDATION AMENDMENTS

NEW CHARTER SCHOOL APPLICATION

Section 1002.33, F.S., authorizes the establishment of charter schools by individuals and/or organizations. As provided in section 1002.33(6), F.S., and School Board Policy 9800 (Charter Schools), Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) receives, and reviews charter school applications submitted by individuals or organizations seeking to establish charter schools within the District. M-DCPS then submits the applications to the School Board with a recommendation for approval or denial. Section 1002.33(6)(b)(2)(a), F.S. requires that the School Board, as the Sponsor, approve or deny an application no later than 90 calendar days after receipt, unless the Sponsor and the applicant mutually agree in writing to temporarily postpone the vote to a specific date.

Pursuant to Policy 9800, the District reviews all applications using an evaluation instrument developed by the Florida Department of Education (FDOE) and may request additional information. The FDOE Standard Model Application includes standards of evaluation, certification and assurance declarations, and an Applicant History Addendum.

Policy 9800 requires the Superintendent to convene the charter school Application Review Committee (ARC) to meet publicly, conduct final reviews of charter school applications, and to provide the Superintendent with a recommendation for presentation to the School Board. The ARC met and identified strengths and/or deficiencies in the written application, as well as areas requiring clarification, to fully evaluate the quality of the application and the capacity of the applicant to properly implement the proposed plan.

Pursuant to Policy 9800, one (1) charter school application and the associated evaluation is being presented for final approval or denial by the School Board as set forth herein. The proposed school, if approved, is anticipated to open for the 2026-2027 school year. It is important to note that, pursuant to section 1002.33(6)(b)(4), F.S., upon written notice at least thirty (30) calendar

days before the first day of school, an approved applicant may defer the opening of the school's operation for up to three years to provide time for adequate facility planning.

An overview of the charter school application is found in Table 1. The application and evaluation instrument can be accessed through the link provided on page 5. The link is included and incorporated by reference in this Board item.

INITIAL CHARTER SCHOOL CONTRACT

Section 1002.33(7), F.S., outlines the issues involved in the operation of charter schools to be considered in advance and written into a charter school contract between the charter school and the School Board following a public meeting. Pursuant to School Board Policy 9800, one (1) initial charter school contract is being presented for consideration in this item.

Policy 9800 requires that the Superintendent convene the Contract Review Committee (CRC) to meet publicly and review initial charter school contracts for presentation to the School Board for their final dispensation. An overview of the contract being presented in this item can be found in Table 2. Additional details for this contract may be found in Attachment A, and the actual contract can be accessed through the link provided on page 5. The attachment and link are included and incorporated by reference in this Board item.

CHARTER SCHOOL CONTRACT AMENDMENTS

Section 1002.33(7)(d), F.S., indicates that a charter may be modified during its term upon the recommendation of the sponsor or the charter school’s governing board and the approval of both parties to the agreement. School Board Policy 9800 requires that the Superintendent convene the CRC to meet publicly and review any substantive amendments to charter school contracts for presentation to the School Board for final consideration.

Pursuant to the law and Policy 9800, five (5) charter school contract amendments are being presented for consideration in this item, as found in Table 3. Additional details regarding these contract amendments may be found in Attachment B. The amended charter contracts can be accessed through the link provided on page 5. The attachment and link are included and incorporated by reference in this Board item.

**Pursuant to s.1002.331(2), F.S., “high-performing” is a designation, made by the Commissioner of Education for certain charter schools, which provides certain authority for the school to increase enrollment (not to exceed facility capacity), expand grade levels, submit quarterly rather than monthly financial reports, consolidate charters, and/or modify the charter term for up to 15 years.*

CHARTER SCHOOL CONSOLIDATIONS

Section 1002.33(7)(d), F.S., states that a charter may be modified during its initial term or any renewal term upon the recommendation of the Sponsor or the charter school’s governing board and the approval of both parties to the agreement. Modification may include, but is not limited to, consolidation of multiple charters into a single charter, if the charters are operated under the same governing board and physically located on the same campus, regardless of the renewal cycle. Upon approval, this consolidation will be presented to the Florida Department of Education which will determine the consolidated Master School Identification Number (MSID).

Pursuant to law, two (2) charter school consolidation requests are being presented in this board item for consideration, as reflected in Table 4. There are two (2) requests to consolidate multiple charter schools into single charter schools with one MSID and to modify the grade levels served by the consolidated schools. Additional details for these charter school consolidations may be found in Attachment C. The charter contracts can be accessed through the link provided on page 5. This attachment and link are included and incorporated by reference in this Board item.

DISTRICT IMPACT

Any significant increase in charter school student enrollment (Charter FTE) directly impacts the District's operating budget as well as instructional and non-instructional staffing levels. The initial charter school contract is included in the analysis of Total Loss (Table 5), as it presents a potential increase in overall charter school enrollment and a corresponding anticipated loss to the District.

Initial Year Loss: 2026-2027 SY. The revenue and positions indicated as "District Impact" provide an estimate of the potential impact on the District's General Fund (\$903,685) instructional staffing (9 positions), and non-instructional staffing (6 positions). The loss of revenue is based on 95% of FEFP funds per student and 75% of the enrollment projection that the District will not realize.

To ensure proper notice and due process, all nonprofit legal entities were notified of the Superintendent's recommendation to the School Board and were provided copies of the charter school application, application evaluation, initial charter school contract, and proposed charter

contract amendments prior to the School Board meeting. RECOMMEND: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida:

- A. Approve one (1) new charter school application with MACS Schools of Education, Inc., d/b/a My Ca.Sa Middle School and authorize the Superintendent to negotiate a charter contract reflecting the contents of the application as approved by the School Board.
- B. Pursuant to section 1002.331, F.S., High-Performing Charter Schools, approve one (1) initial charter school contract with Pinecrest Academy, Inc., d/b/a Pinecrest Preparatory Academy Middle School (MSID TBD) for a five (5)-year term commencing July 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2031.
- C. Approve five (5) charter school contract amendments with:
 1. Mater Academy, Inc., d/b/a Mater Biscayne Academy North Miami Middle School (MSID 5555), incorporating a newly negotiated charter contract to replace the existing contract and, pursuant to section 1002.331, F.S., High-Performing Charter Schools, modifying the current contract term from five (5) years to fifteen (15) years, commencing July 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2037;
 2. Miami Community Charter Schools, Inc., d/b/a Miami Community Charter High School (MSID 7058), adopting a newly negotiated charter contract to replace the existing contract and adding additional applicable folio numbers
