SUBJECT: PRESENTATION OF THE QUARTERLY SCHOOL SAFETY COMPLIANCE REPORT TO THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA

The Florida Department of Education (FLDOE), pursuant to Florida Statute 1001.212(13), has an established process for monitoring of school safety requirements. Under this statute, the FLDOE's Office of Safe Schools (OSS) is required to conduct unannounced inspections of all public schools, including charter schools, on a triannual basis. All unannounced inspections are done while school is in session.

Beginning with the 2024-2025 school year, as part of the ongoing compliance inspections, the OSS is required to provide to each district school superintendent and school safety specialist quarterly reports identifying the number and percentage of schools, including charter schools, that received unannounced inspections, or were reinspected during that quarter, and the number and percentage of inspected schools that had no school safety requirement deficiencies.

Florida Statute 1001.212(13) further requires the school safety specialist to present each OSS quarterly report to the district School Board. This quarterly report and all associated information are classified as *For Official Use Only* and are protected from public disclosure under s. 281.301 F.S., s. 286.0113 F.S. and s. 1006.1493(5) F.S., and exempt from public records requests under s. 119.071 (2) (d) and 119.071(3)(a) F.S.

The FLDOE OSS school safety compliance report for the fourth quarter of the school year, April 1, 2026 – June 30, 2026, will be forwarded to the Board under separate cover prior to the Board Meeting of July 22, 2026.

RECOMMENDED: That the School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, receive the school safety compliance report for the fourth quarter of the school year, dated April 1, 2026 – June 30, 2026.
