**SUBJECT: AUTHORIZATION TO ASSESS EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY
FEES FOR THE 2026-2027 SCHOOL YEAR**

2026 Florida Senate Bill 538 (S.B. 538) authorizes public schools, with Board approval, to charge activity fees to students not enrolled in the school, but who are eligible to participate in interscholastic and intra-scholastic extracurricular activities.

Consistent with S.B. 538, authorization is being requested for District schools to assess an activity fee of four hundred dollars (\$400) to private schools and personalized education plan students during the 2026-2027 school year.

A complete list of all activity fees will be published on each school's website before the school year starts and will be reported to the Florida Department of Education.

RECOMMENDED: That the School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, approve extracurricular activity fees for private school and personalized education plan students for the 2026-2027 school year.

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
