SUBJECT: INITIAL **READING: PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SCHOOL
BOARD BYLAW 0173, *DISTRICT STRATEGIC PLAN***

Consistent with the Board's responsibility to review and update policies, and pursuant to Board action, authorization is requested to initiate rulemaking proceedings to amend School Board Bylaw 0173, *District Strategic Plan*. Bylaw 0173 is proposed for amendment pursuant to June 2026 agenda item H-5, "Strategic Plan Alignment Review Process," proffered by Board Member Luisa Santos, which directed the Superintendent to establish a strategic plan alignment review process to ensure applicable District initiatives, budget priorities, capital projects, and policy proposals are evaluated for alignment with the Decision Matrix for New Initiatives & Programs included in the Board-adopted Strategic Plan (except that initiatives, expenditures, projects, programs, or actions required to comply with applicable federal, state, or local laws, regulations, or court orders, would be exempt from such review), and to initiate rulemaking, as deemed necessary, no later than September 2026.

Pursuant to this item, Bylaw 0173 is proposed for amendment to require that applicable District initiatives, budget priorities, capital projects, and policy proposals are evaluated for alignment with the Board-adopted Strategic Plan. The amended bylaw would require the Superintendent to coordinate the comprehensive planning, monitoring and reporting process for the District Strategic Plan. Additionally, the amended bylaw would require the Superintendent to evaluate applicable District initiatives, budget priorities, capital projects, and policy proposals (excluding initiatives, expenditures, or actions required to comply with applicable federal, state, or local laws, regulations, court orders, or those necessary to address immediate health, safety, or operational emergencies) against the Board-adopted Decision Matrix for New Initiatives & Programs to classify items as Strategic Priorities or Secondary Priorities.

These amendments were drafted in collaboration with, and reviewed by the Superintendent, Cabinet, and District staff. The Notice of Intended Action and policy with strikethroughs and underlines are attached.

RECOMMENDED:

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to initiate rulemaking proceedings in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act to amend School Board Bylaw 0173, *District Strategic Plan*.

ANY PERSON WHO DECIDES TO APPEAL THE DECISION made by the School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, with respect to this action will need to ensure the preparation of a verbatim record of the proceedings, including the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based. 0173 – **DISTRICT STRATEGIC PLAN**

I. **Basis for the District Strategic Plan**

- A. Strategic planning is the systematic process of specifying the goals derived from the mission, vision, and core values of the school system, determining the present attainment of those goals, and then selecting strategies to reduce the discrepancies. The major emphasis of the District's planning system shall be the achievement by all students of State and local goals. The District Strategic Plan ~~provides~~serves as the strategic framework for all aspects of the District school system toward the accomplishment of ~~these~~ identified goals and alignment of resource allocation. The District Strategic Plan supports the School Board's duties to implement school improvement and education accountability, as set forth in F.S. 1001.42(18), and State Board of Education rules.
- B. To fulfill its duties, the Board requires the establishment of an Educational Excellence School Advisory Council (EESAC) for each school pursuant to Board Policy 2125, *Educational Excellence School Advisory Council*, and a School Improvement Plan for each school that is presented to and approved by the Board annually in accordance with Board Policy 2120, *School Improvement Through Comprehensive District-Wide Planning*. Elements of the District Strategic Plan inform the school improvement planning process, which includes the involvement and cooperation of those closest to the school: administrators, faculty, staff, parents, students, as well as external stakeholders.

II. ~~Process for the~~ District Strategic Plan Process and Alignment

A. Strategic Plan Development

The Superintendent shall coordinate the comprehensive planning process for the District Strategic Plan. The District Strategic Plan shall be comprehensive, and shall include but not be limited to, ~~priorities and~~ objectives and goals to support the District's most significant challenges and opportunities identified goal(s). The District Strategic Plan must, at a minimum, include objectives and appropriate metrics ~~and/or key performance indicators (KPIs)~~, appropriate data sources, and a tentative reporting timeline. The District Strategic Plan shall be thoroughly reassessed and reevaluated in its entirety no less than every five (5) years, or for some other period as approved by the Board. The process for revising, developing, and/or amending the District Strategic Plan must occur no less than six (6) months prior to the expiration of the previous District Strategic Plan.

B. Strategic Plan Monitoring Process

The Superintendent shall coordinate ~~the comprehensive planning process and monitoring and reporting~~ progress on ~~the accomplishment of District Strategic Planning goals, priorities, and~~ objectives and goals specified in the District Strategic Plan. An update on the status and progress towards achievement of the goal(s) included in the District Strategic Plan, including any adjustments, shall be presented by the Superintendent and approved by the Board annually. To ensure progress monitoring and transparency, a mid-year update of available strategic planning data will also be transmitted to the Board at the appropriate Board committee meeting or workshop. The mid-year update should be provided by March of each year. Quarterly updates on the District Strategic Plan may additionally be provided to the Board at relevant Board committee meetings or workshops as the Superintendent deems such quarterly updates appropriate. ~~The process for revising, developing, and/or amending the District Strategic Plan must occur no less than six (6) months prior to the expiration of the previous District Strategic Plan.~~

C. Strategic Plan Alignment

i. The Superintendent shall evaluate applicable District initiatives, budget priorities, capital projects, and policy proposals against the Board-adopted Decision Matrix for New Initiatives & Programs included in the Strategic Plan to classify proposed actions as Strategic Priorities or Secondary Priorities.

ii. The requirement to evaluate proposed actions against the Decision Matrix for New Initiatives & Programs shall not apply to initiatives, expenditures, or actions required to comply with applicable federal, state, or local laws, regulations, court orders, or those necessary to address immediate health, safety, or operational emergencies. Such actions are classified as Business-as-Usual activities with operational impact and may be taken without further action under this policy.
