- **Opportunities for Students who Defer Receipt of the Standard High School Diploma:**
 - Courses necessary to satisfy the scholar designation requirements
 - Courses that align to the student's post-secondary goals
 - Dual Enrollment
 - Industry certification courses that lead to college credit
 - Structured Work-Study, pre-internship or pre-apprenticeship programs
 - Transition Courses, including Career Education, Career Experiences, Career Placement, Career Preparation, Preparation for Adult Living, Preparation for Entrepreneurship/Self-Employment, Transition Planning, and Supported Competitive Employment

- **Employment Training Programs**
 - **Project Victory:** Vocational Instruction, Community, and Training Opportunities for Youth
 - Half-day at a designated worksite and half-day at the school site
 - **Project STRIVE:** Post-secondary specialized Career and Technical Education program with a focus on Culinary Arts
 - Half-day at JRE Lee Educational Center and half-day at the school site
 - **Project Bridges to Tomorrow:** Post-secondary Career and Technical Education program with a focus on Technology Education
 - Half-day at Barbara Goleman SHS and half-day at the school site

- **School-to-Work Programs**
 - **Project BRIDGE:** Building Recreational Independence and Developing Gateways to Employment
 - Full-day at the worksite (Shake-a-Leg Miami)
 - **Project SEARCH:** Enhancing employability skills while participating in a variety of rotations which lead to competitive employment
 - Full-day at the worksite (City of Hialeah, City of Miami or Zoo Miami)
