To provide information regarding training for the administration of the Florida Alternate Assessment (FAA)-Performance Task

- The Florida Alternate Assessment (FAA)-Performance Task is designed to demonstrate student mastery of the Florida Access Points. It is administered to students who are on a modified curriculum in the following subjects and grade levels:
 - English/Language Arts 1 and 2: students in 3rd through 10th grades Access course
 - Mathematics: students in 3rd through 8th grades Access course
 - Writing: students in 4th through 10th grades Access course
 - Science: students in 5th and 8th grades Access course
 - Middle School End of Course: students enrolled in the Access Civics course
 - High School End of Courses: students enrolled in Access Algebra I, Access Geometry, Access Biology I and U.S. History course(s)
- The Florida Alternate Assessment (FAA)-Performance Task is administered to each student individually by the student's teacher, a certified teacher, or other licensed professional who has worked extensively with the student and who has completed training in the assessment procedures.
- All teachers administering the FAA Performance Task **must complete** one of the two required training options.
- **Option 1: All NEW teachers and teachers that have NOT administered the assessment within the last three years** and who have students who will participate in the Florida Alternate Assessment (FAA)-Performance Task are required to attend a one-day, in-person Florida Alternate Assessment (FAA) Administration Training session. Sessions will be scheduled on the following dates:
 - Thursday, November 14, 2024, from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. at **North Miami Senior High School**, 13110 NE 8th Avenue, North Miami, Florida, 33161
 - Wednesday, December 11, 2024, from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. at **Miami Norland Senior High School**, 1193 NW 193rd Street, Miami Gardens, Florida 33169
 - Wednesday, January 22, 2025, from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. at **Miami Coral Park Senior High School**, 8865 SW 16th Street, Miami, Florida 33165
 - Thursday, February 6, 2025, from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. at **Miami Sunset Senior High School**, 13125 SW 72nd street, Miami, 33183
 - Participants must register for a session through the Frontline Professional Learning Management System, under the activity title "District Led Training for the Florida Alternate Assessment (FAA) – Performance Task". Participants will earn seven (7) Master Plan Points (MPP) for their completion of the training.
- **Option 2: Teachers who completed the in-person training last year** are required to complete the Florida Alternate Assessments (FAA) Online Modules accessible through the Learning Management System [FAA Learning Management System](#) in order to satisfy the training requirement.

- Teachers who do not complete one of the two training options **will not have access** to the Test Information Distribution Engine (TIDE) and the Data Entry Interface (DEI) platform for assessment.
