Description

This project is for the reroofing of Thomas Jefferson Middle School with an SBS modified roof membrane system installed over lightweight insulating concrete and installation of a roof storm water disposal system and mechanical system modification.

Staff recommended rejection of the contract because the low, responsive bidder, Triple M Roofing Corp. is significantly over the construction budget.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida:

- reject the low, responsive bidder on Project No. A-0672,
 Roof Replacement and Site Drainage, Thomas Jefferson
 Middle School because the bid significantly exceeds the construction budget; and
- b) direct the Superintendent to review the bid documents and advertise rebidding of the project.
