REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR FUNDING THE FLORIDA LEARN AND SERVE AMERICA GRANT PROGRAM, SEPTEMBER 1, 1999 - AUGUST 31, 2000

The Florida Department of Education issued Request for Proposals to public schools for service-learning projects. All schools and district offices were invited to participate in this grant initiative. These funds are part of the Florida Learn and Serve America Grant Program funded under the Corporation for National Service. The goal of the program is to expand service-learning opportunities for K-12 youth through the integration of service into the academic curricula.

Grant funds have been awarded, in the total amount of \$32,965, to cover salaries, supplies, materials, equipment, recognition awards, transportation, and contracted services. The projects will focus on the following areas: intergenerational activities, ecological restoration, conflict resolution, tutorial services, environmental education, youth service council projects, and adult literacy.

There is a requirement of a 33 percent match for new applicants, 50 percent match for second-year applicants and 100 percent match for third-year applicants. The match will be met by the schools and district offices through the contribution of space, technical assistance, administrative and clerical support, materials, and support from community and business partners.

During the 1998-99 school year, Miami-Dade County Public Schools received funds, in the amount of \$39,157, under this funding initiative.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education, in the amount of \$32,965, for funding the Florida Learn and Serve America Grant Program, September 1, 1999 - August 31, 2000; and
- 2. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
