I am exercising my responsibility as Superintendent of Schools and recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of January 12, 2000, that the School Board suspend you, for 30 workdays from your current position as Teacher at Coral Gables Senior High School, effective at the close of the workday, January 12, 2000, for just cause, including, but not limited to misconduct in office, and violation of School Board Rules, 6Gx13-5D-1.07, Corporal Punishment-Prohibited, 6Gx13-4-1.08, Violence in the Workplace, and 6Gx13-4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 230.03(2), 230.23(5)(f), 231.36(1)(a), 231.36(6)(a), and 447.209, Florida Statutes.

You have forfeited, in writing, your right to contest your suspension.

RECOMMENDED: That effective January 12, 2000, at the close of the workday, the School Board suspend Mr. Les Jackson, Teacher at Coral Gables Senior High School, for 30 workdays.
