At its meeting of June 21, 2000, the Board commissioned James B. Pirtle Construction Company, Inc. as CM-at-Risk for North Beach Elementary School. This contract provides for construction services to the Board and a Guaranteed Maximum Price for construction.

The Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) by the Construction Manager, James B. Pirtle Construction Company, Inc. is in the sum of \$4,212,109 (contingency of \$159,752 is included) and is 7.1% under the independent cost estimate of \$3,914,693. This GMP covers all required work and includes subcontracts, materials, contingency, general conditions, bond, and overhead and profit.
