At its meeting of June 21, 2000, the Board commissioned 3D/International, Inc. as CM-at-Risk for Biscayne Elementary School. This contract provides for construction services to the Board and a Guaranteed Maximum Price for construction.

The Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) by the Construction Manager, 3D/International, Inc. is in the sum of \$654,005 (contingency included \$25,154) and is 31.1% under the independent cost estimate of \$857,570 (contingency of \$40,836 included). This GMP covers all required work and includes subcontracts, materials contingency, general conditions, bond, and overhead and profit.
