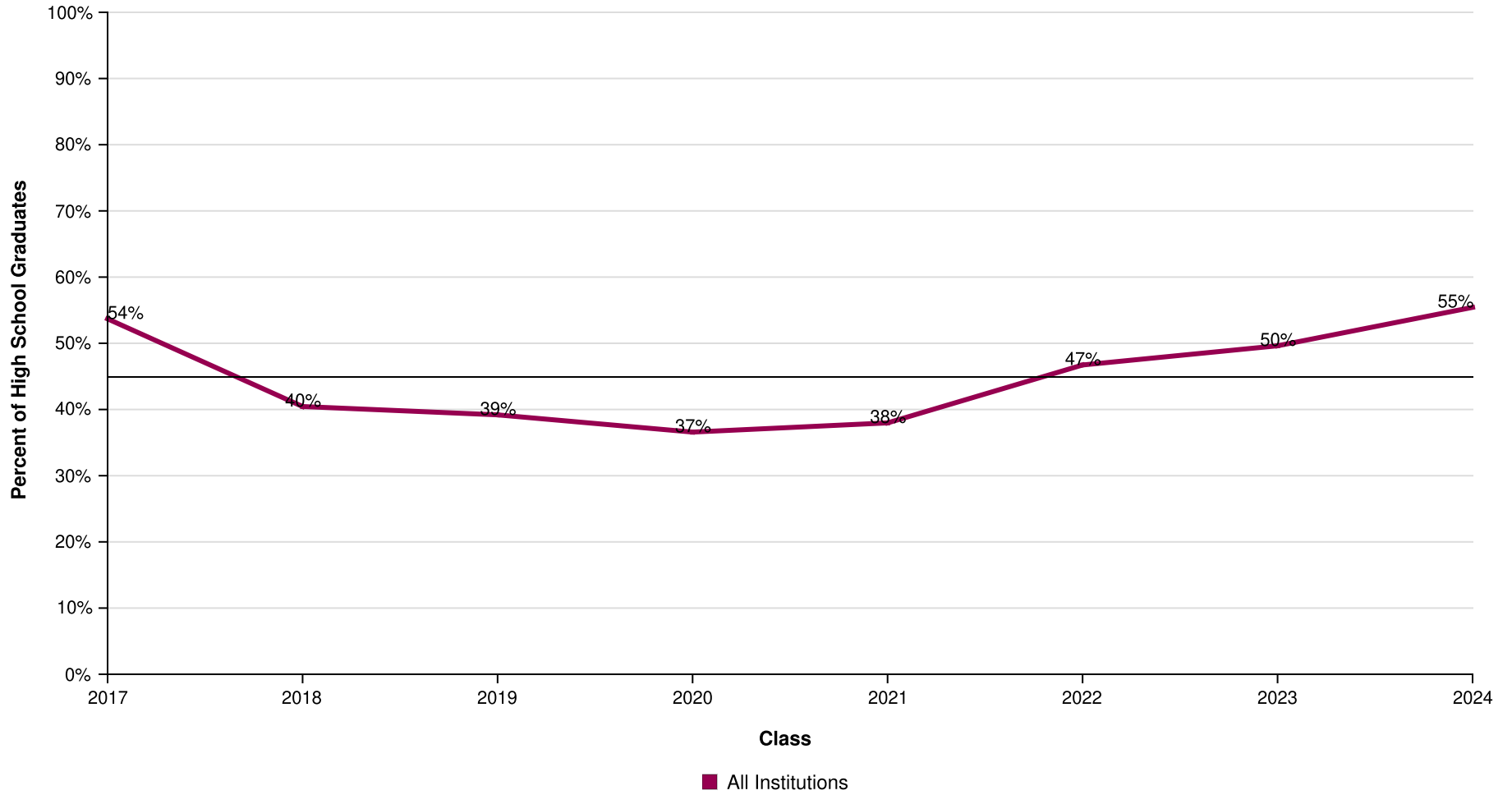

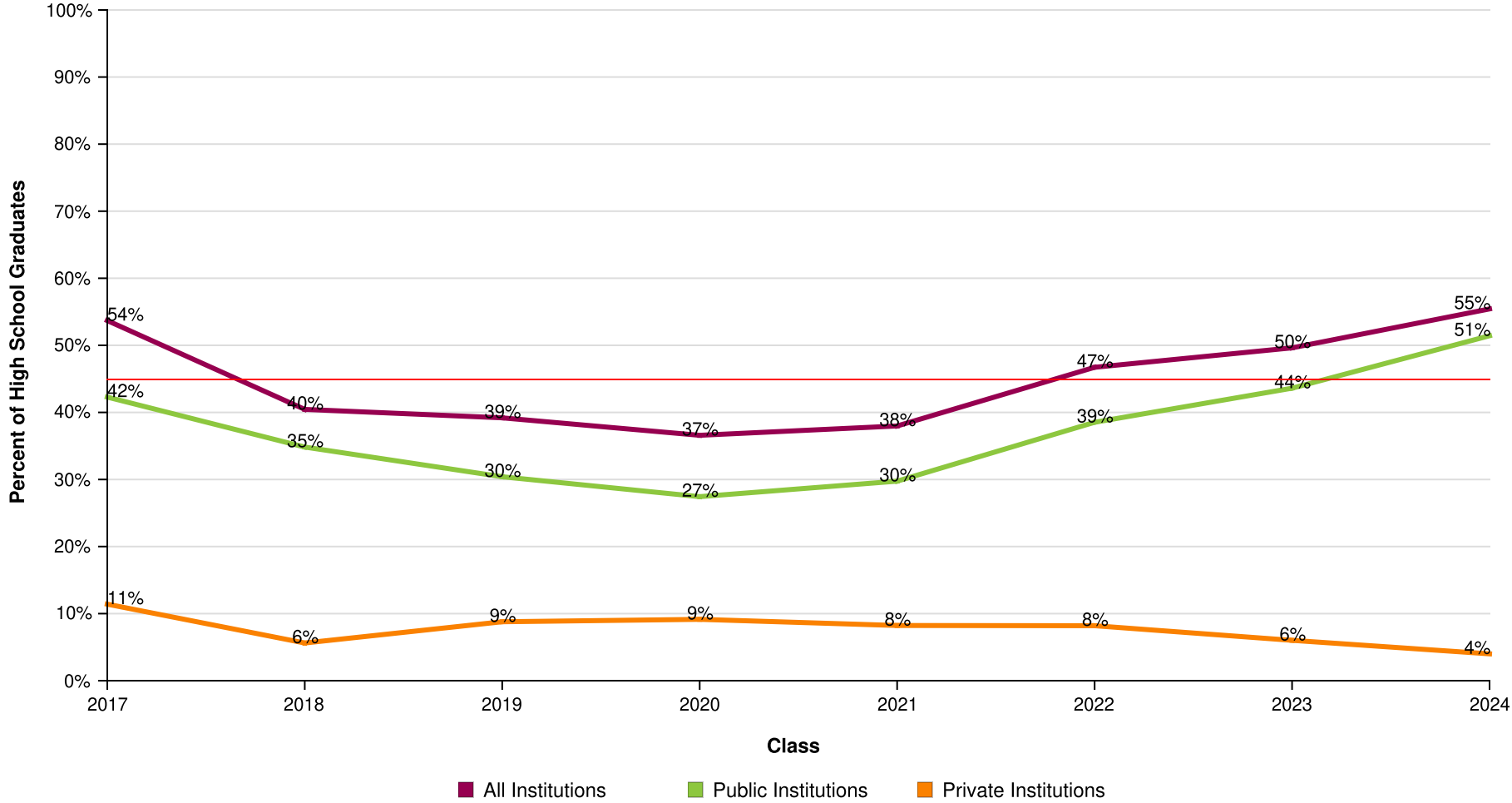

Percent of Students Enrolled in College the Fall Immediately After High School by Institutional Type

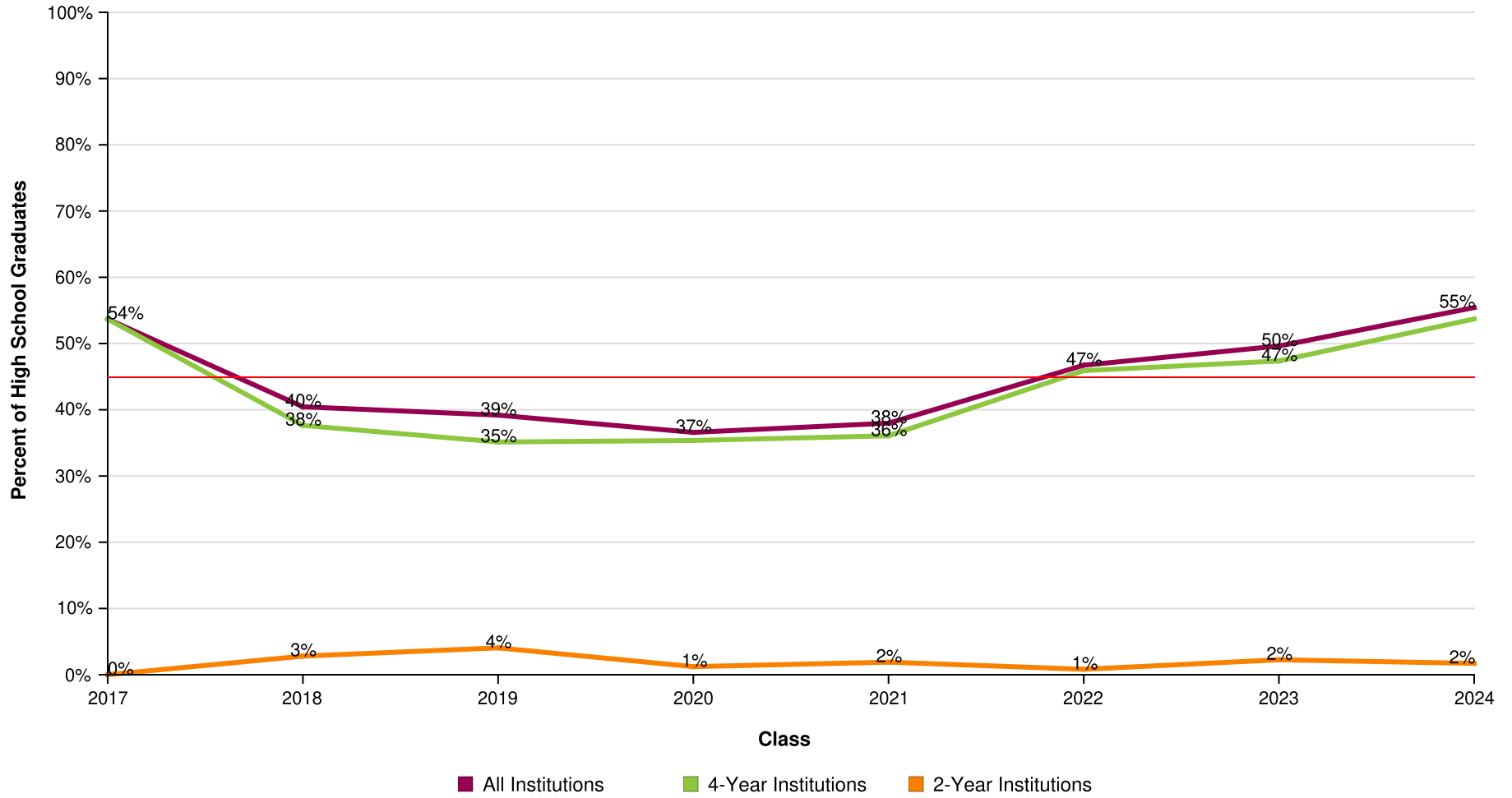

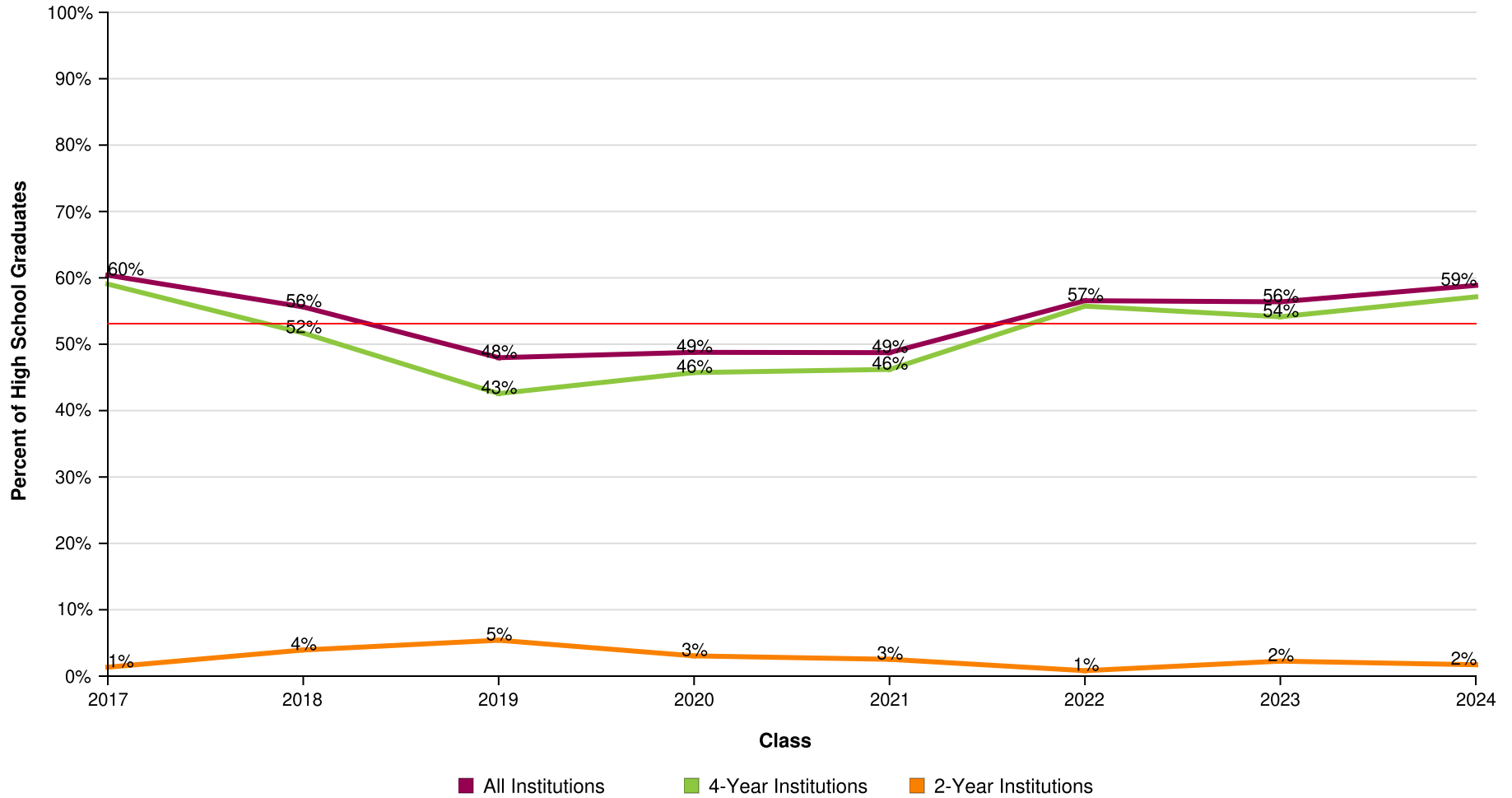

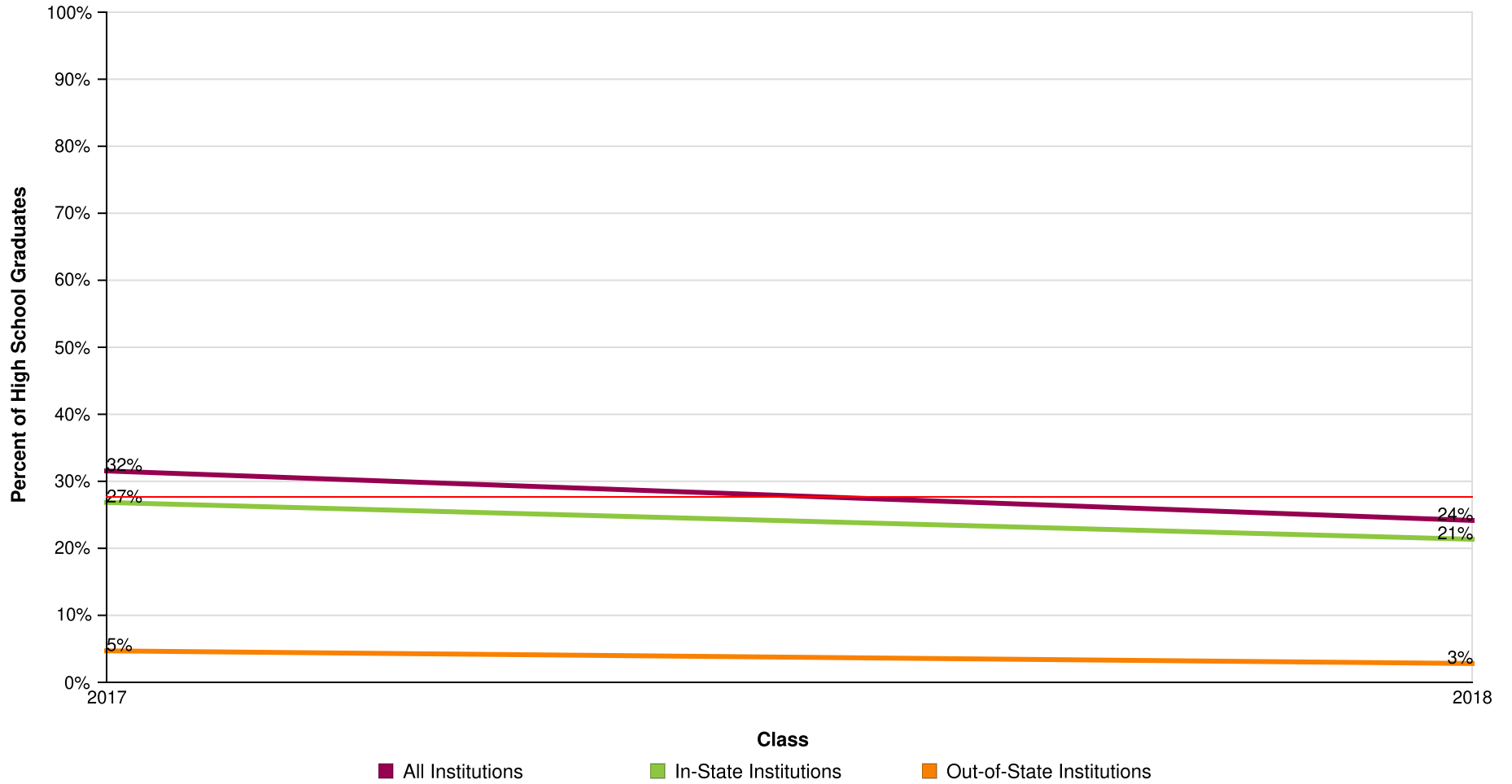

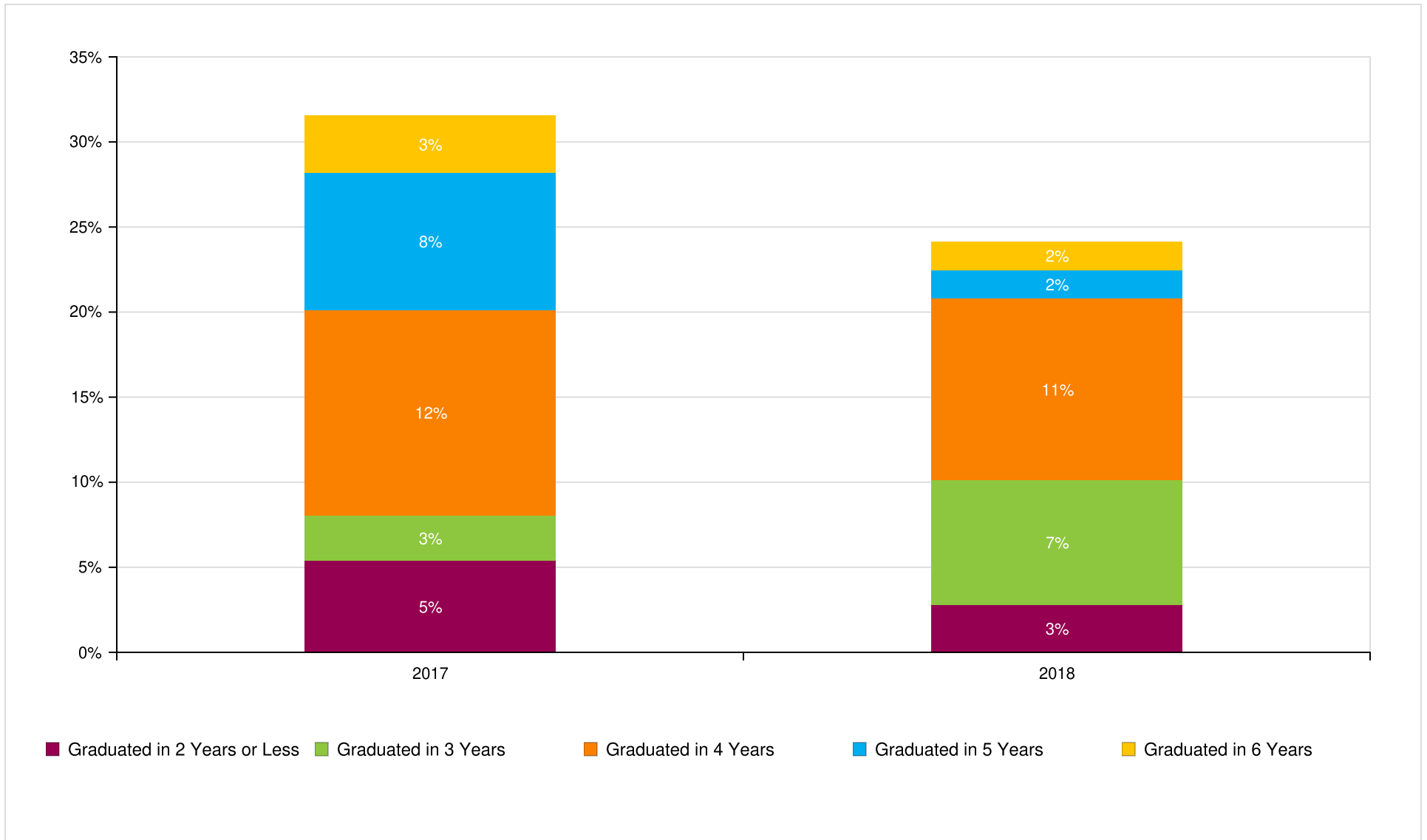

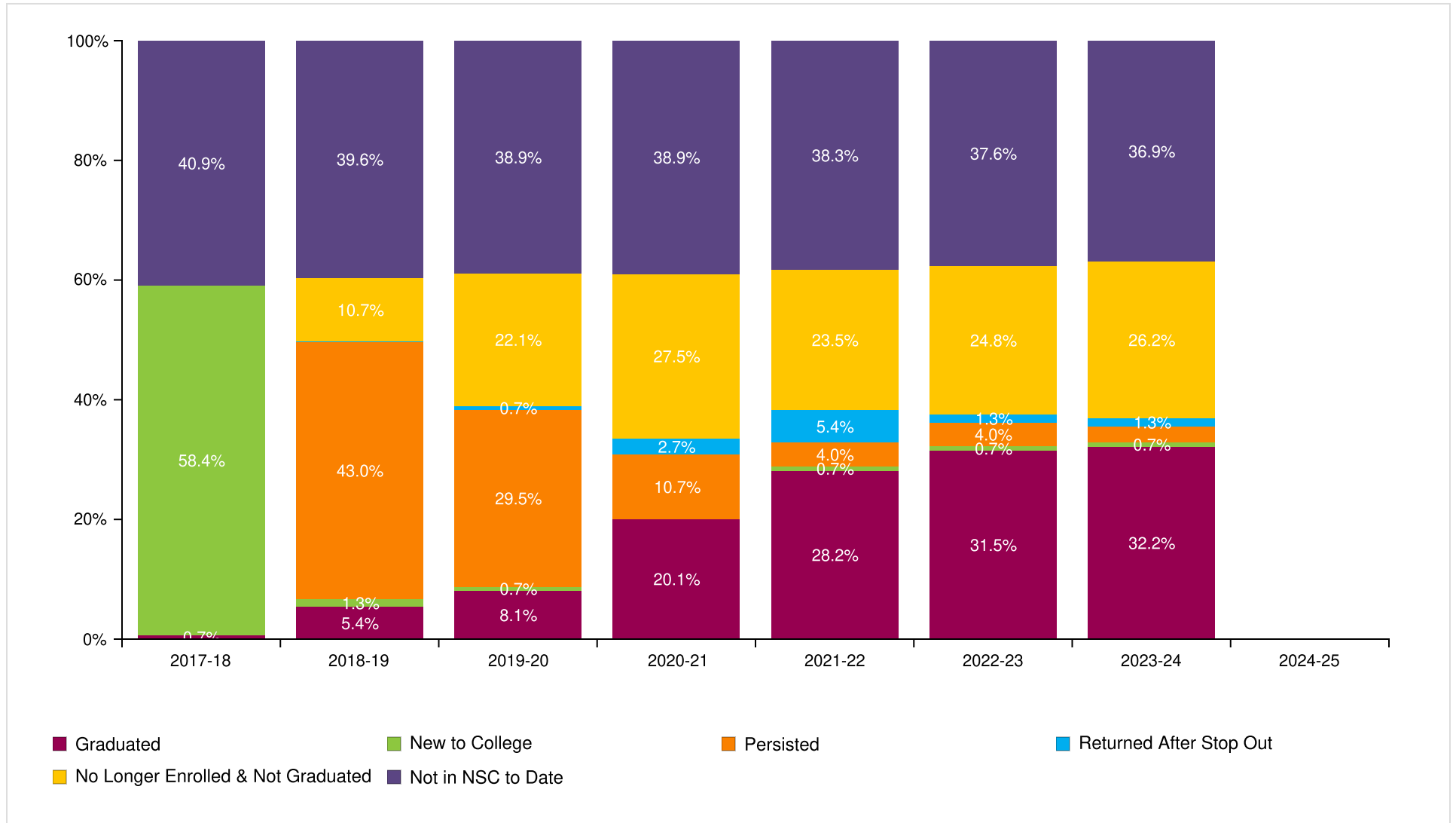

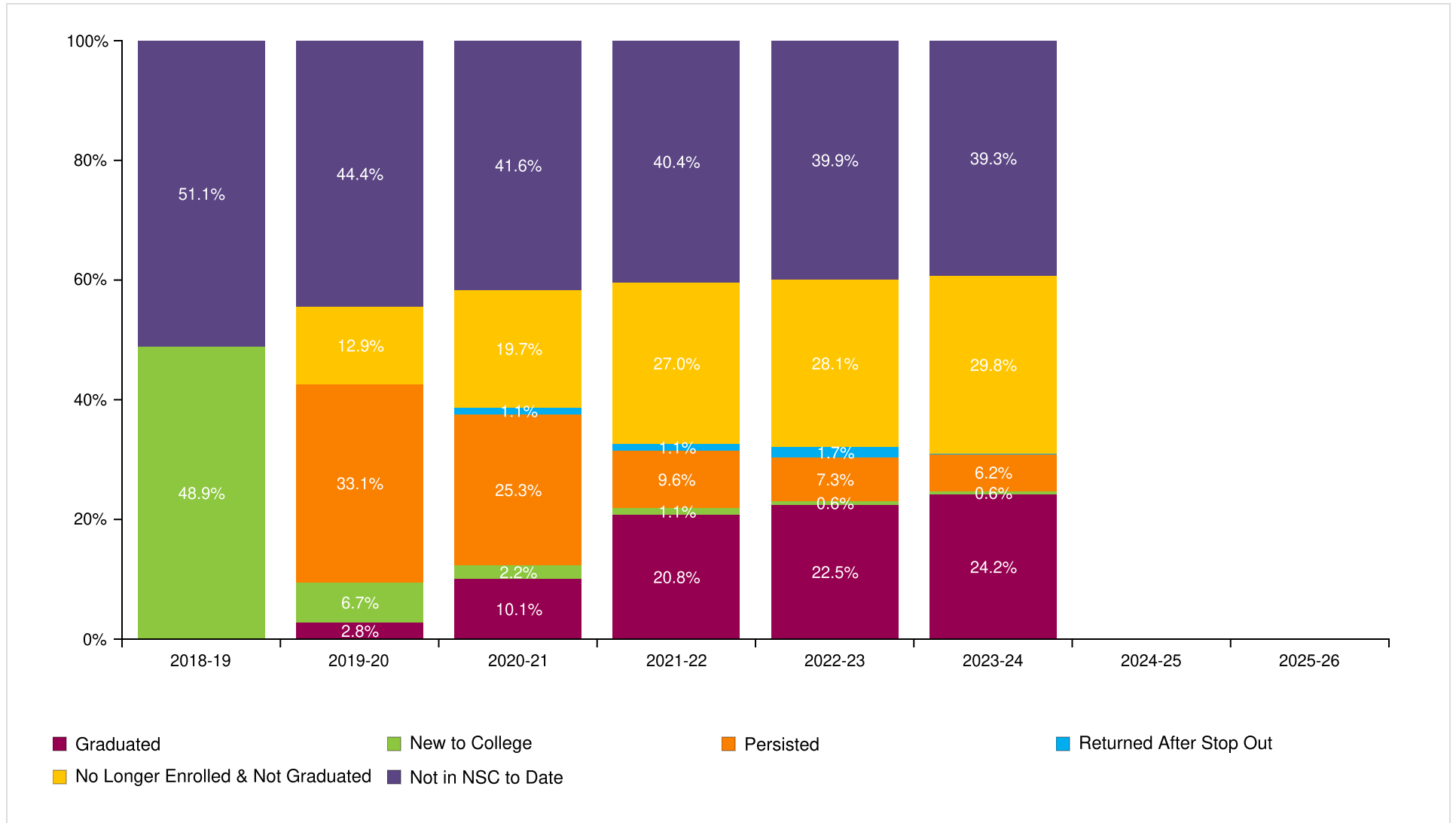

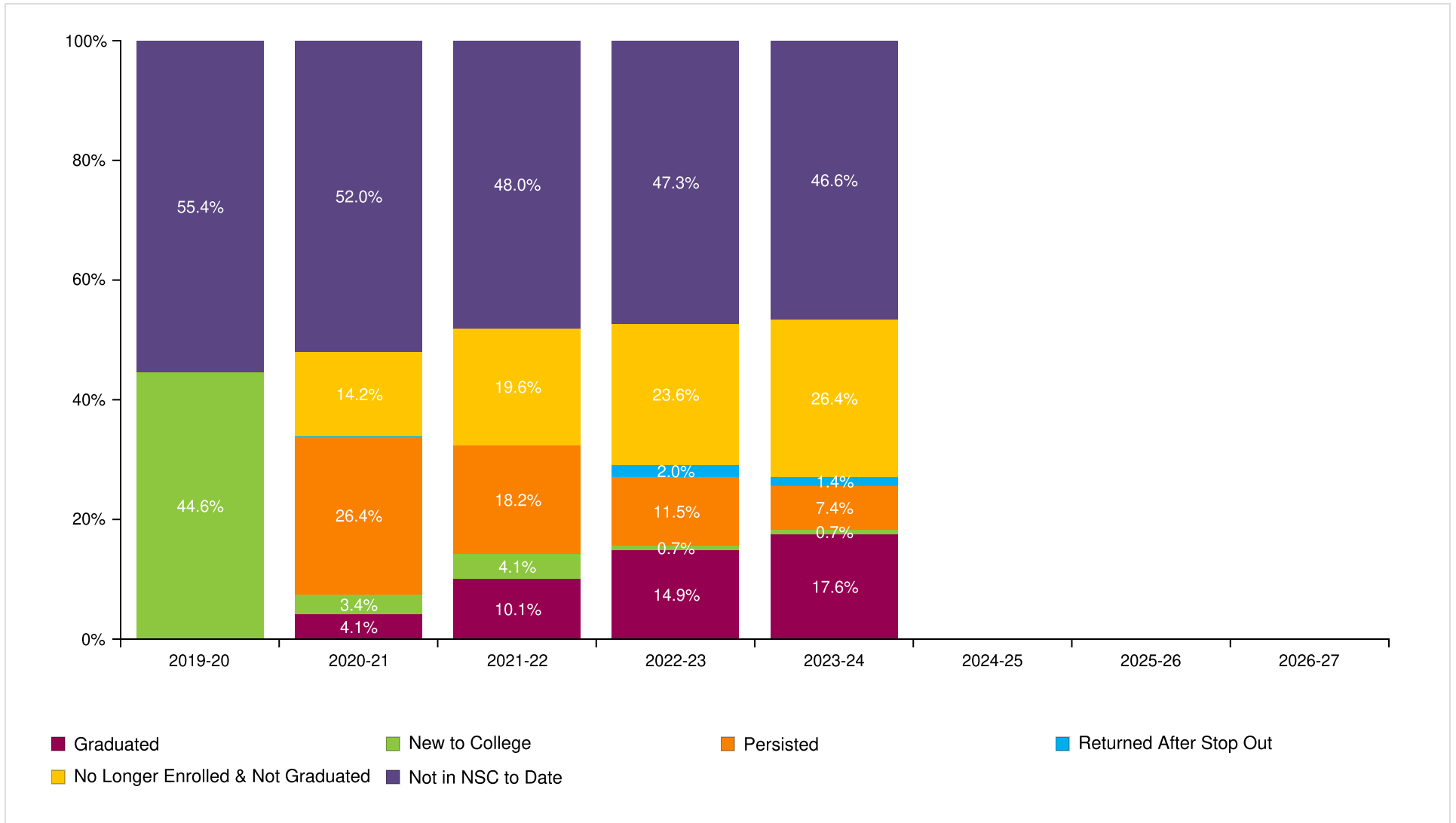

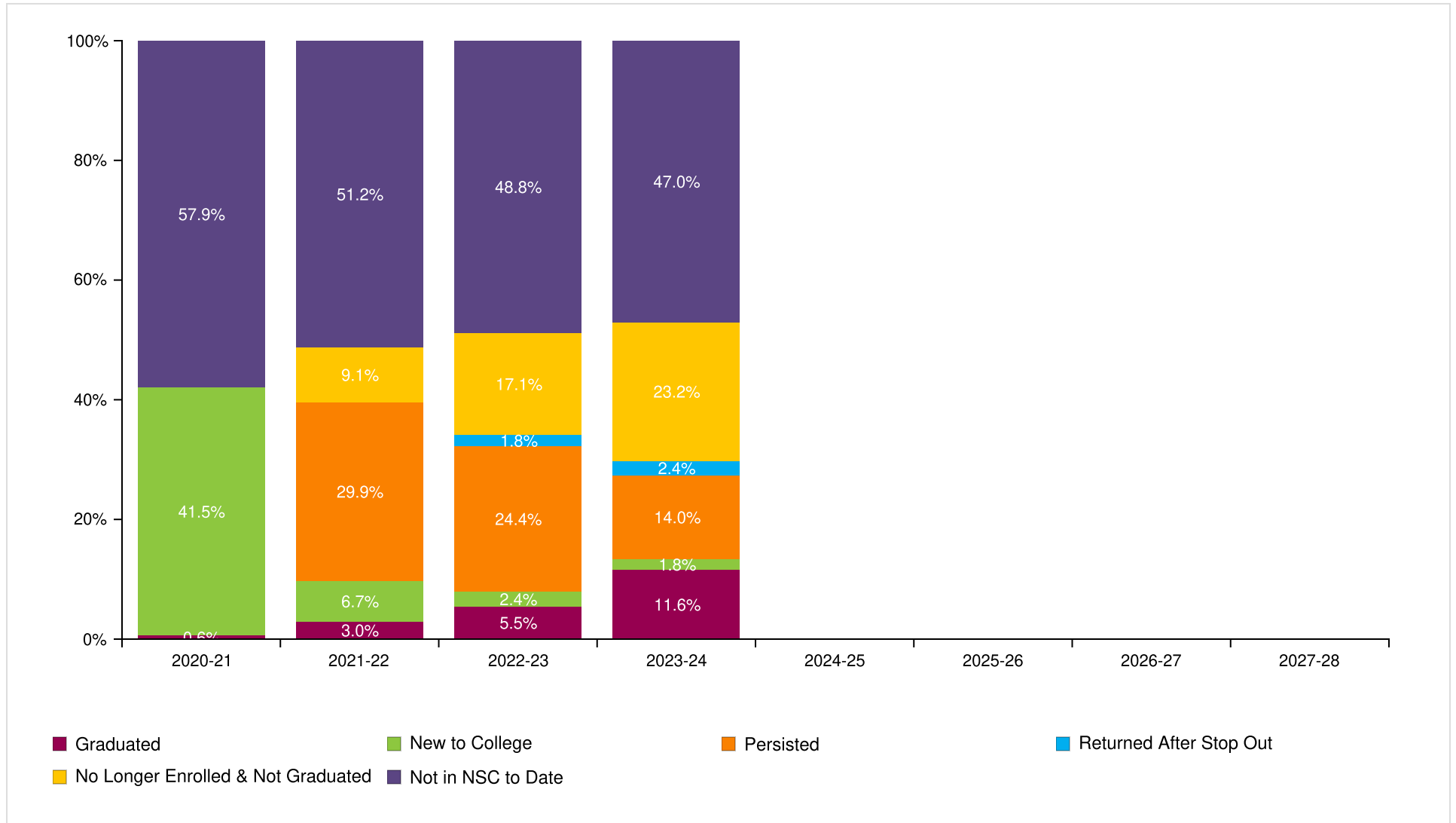

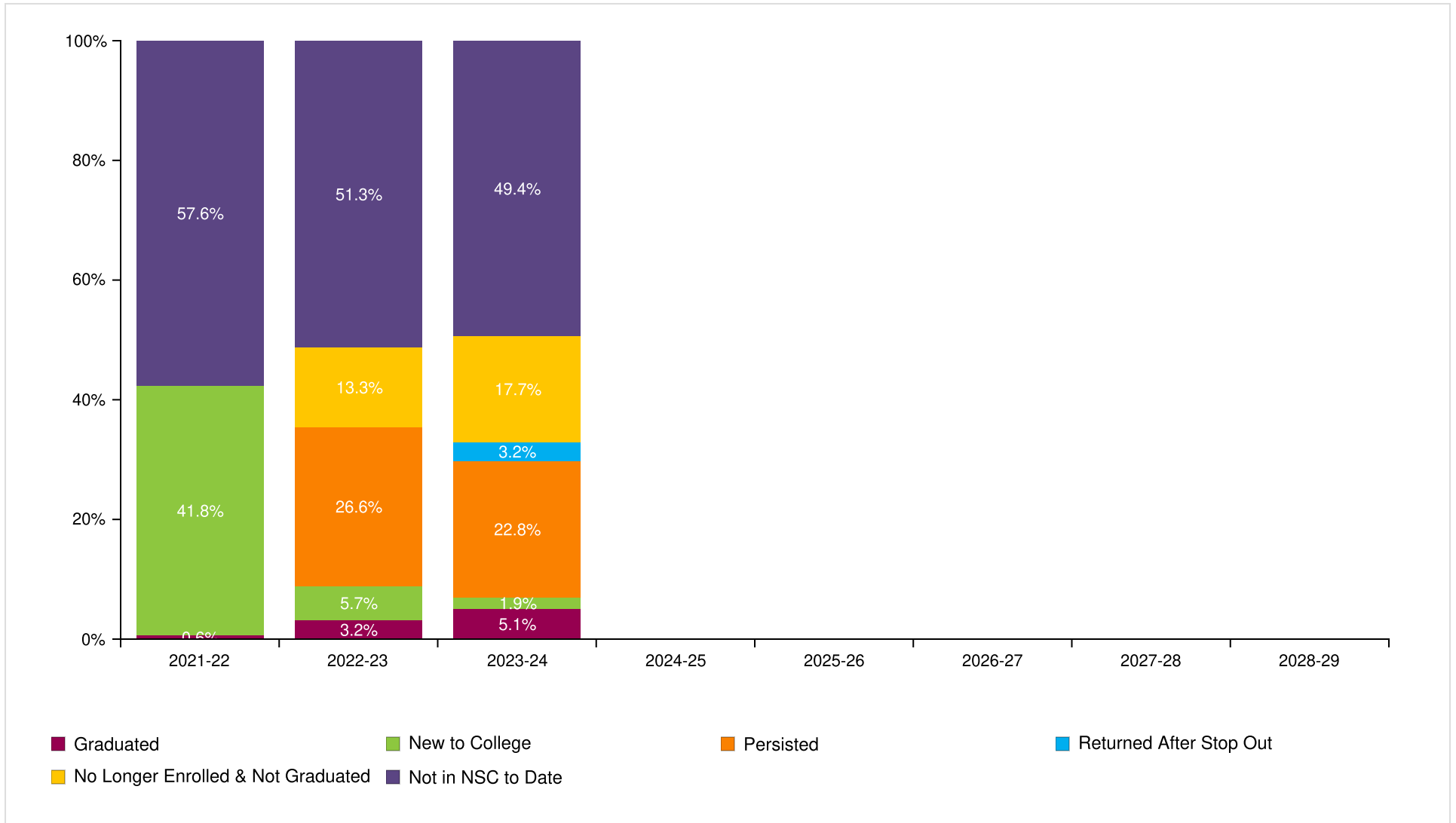

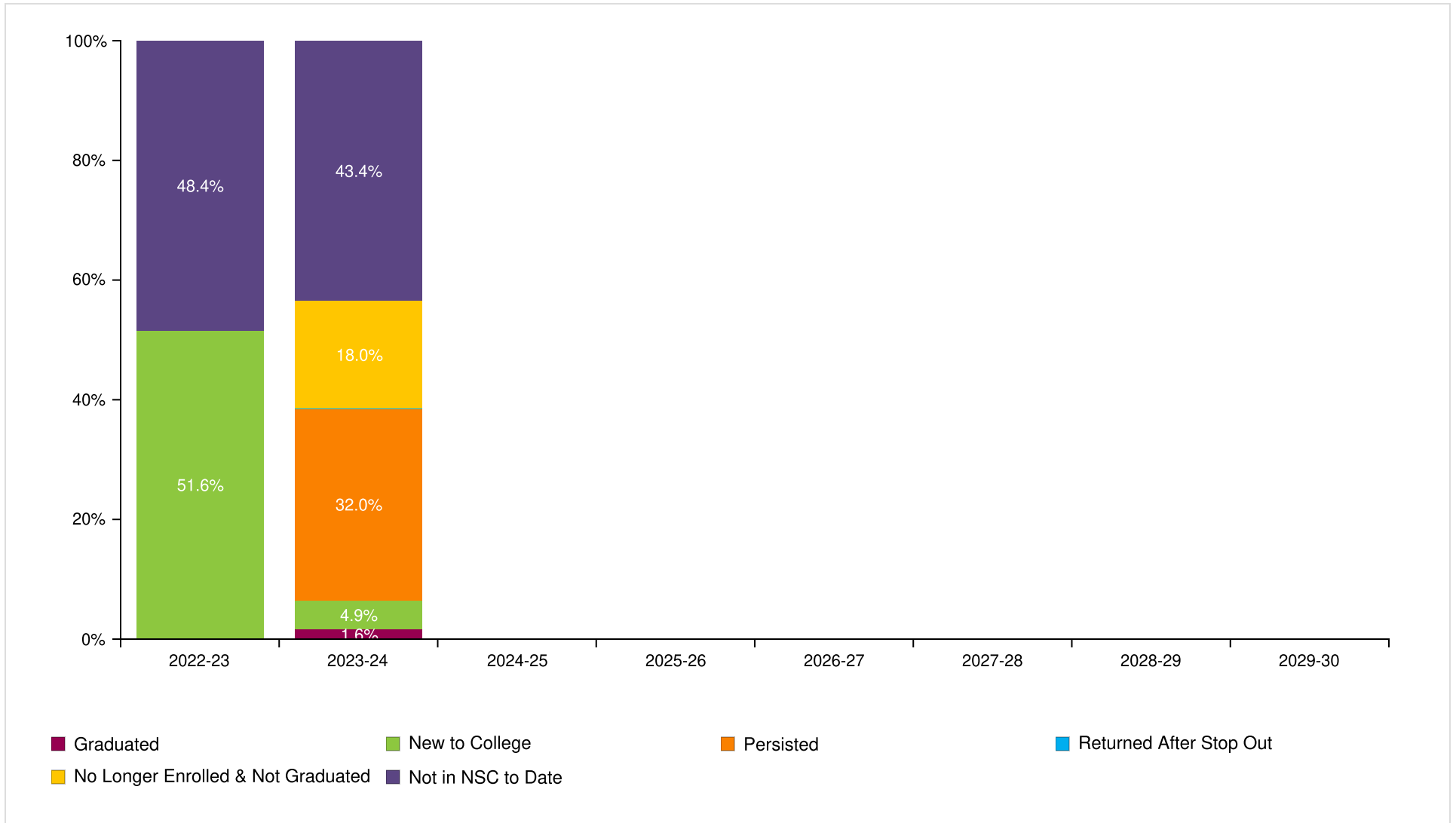

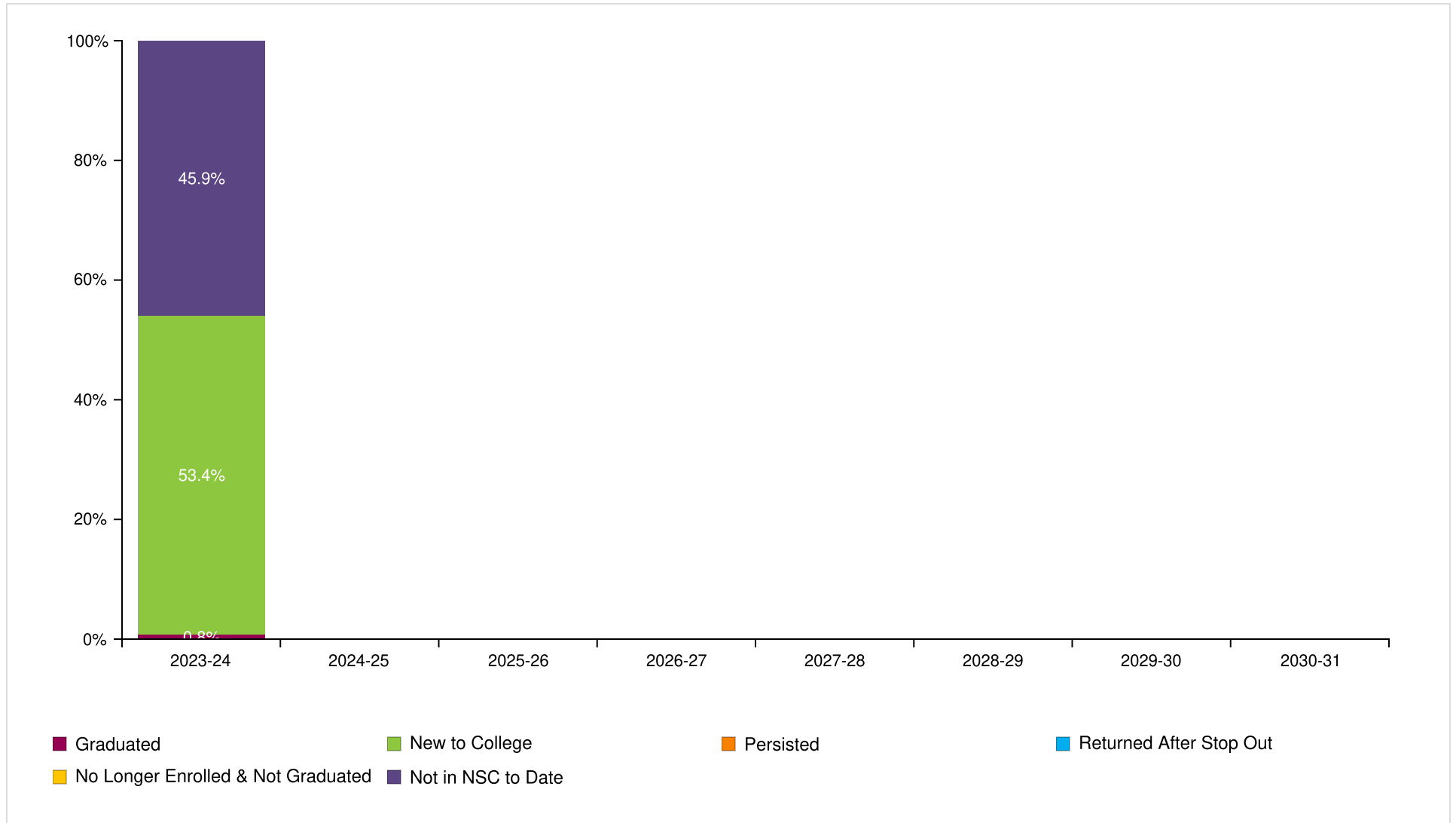

**Institutions that participate in the Clearinghouse represent more that 98% of the nation's two- and four-year postsecondary enrollment. Students who are enrolled in postsecondary institutions that do not participate in the Clearinghouse are not in the Clearinhouse database.
